Awards

The winners in each category in each competition are awarded the title of Lithuanian ARDF Champion.

The 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place holders are awarded medals on Lithuanian national ribbon and certificates.

Arrival and transportation

According to IARU R1

Transmitters

Foxoring: 3x5 transmitters (slow 1...5 3.510 MHz, medium 1A...5A 3.540 MHz, fast 1F...5F 3.570 MHz, ~10mW, vertical antenna 20 cm) + beacon (3.600MHz, 1W, vertical antenna 8 m + 4x2 m counterpoise).

80 m classic: 5 transmitters (3.540 MHz) + beacon (3.600MHz), all 1W, vertical antenna 8 m + 4x2 m counterpoise.

2 m classic: 5 transmitters (144.500MHz) + beacon (144.800 MHz), all 1W, cross dipole antenna, 2.5 m above ground.
